CLINIC INFORMATION

WHAT TYPE OF HEALTH CARE IS PROVIDED?

Church Health Services is very interested in helping you with your health care needs. Nurses, clergy, physicians, nurse practitioners and physician assistants will provide this help. These health care professionals from our community volunteer their time for this very important work. They all work together as a team to provide you with a high level of care and you are an important member of that team. Your active involvement in your health care is key. The actual clinic facility is similar to that found in a regular doctor's office. The educational rooms of a church have been temporarily converted to fully equipped, private examination rooms. WHEN IS THE CLINIC OPEN?

Clinic sessions are held several times throughout the month and clinic visits are by appointment only. **It is important for you to be aware that health care from Church Health Services is only available during those clinic sessions. If a medical concern arises outside of these clinic sessions, it is your responsibility to seek health care from another setting like your personal physician or an area emergency room.** Our staff are however available by phone throughout the week. Usual office hours are Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 9am-1pm. An answering machine is available to leave messages that are not of an emergency or urgent nature.

WHERE IS IT LOCATED?

The clinics of Church Health Services are located in the east educational wing of Trinity Church - United Methodist at 308 Oneida Street in Beaver Dam. Patients are asked to use the Grove Street entrance. See "Contact Us" section of Web site for city map.

WHAT ARE THE FEES?

Although no specific fees are charged for services, each patient is asked to provide a donation at each office visit. These donations are needed for the continued support of the clinic.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR CARE?

Church Health Services was started to help those people in our area communities who have difficulty in receiving basic health care because of low income and no health insurance. Our service area includes most of Dodge County plus a few neighboring communities located just outside the northeastern county border. The Service Area tab of this website includes a completing listing of our area communities.

So, if you live in one of our area communities, meet certain income guidelines, and do not have any private or public health insurance like Medicare, Medicaid or Badger Care, you may be eligible for services in our clinics. Please complete a Patient Application available on this website. A determination of eligibility will be made after its review.

WHAT IS THE ROLE OF THE CHURCH?

Church Health Services is supported by many area churches and community groups. Our staff and volunteers are committed to this particular health care work because of their personal faith in God and their concern for the health of their neighbor. Also, recent research is showing that a person's faith may indeed impact their health. Please remember the staff of Church Health Services will care for you regardless of the specifics of your personal faith.

WHAT DO PATIENTS SAY ABOUT THEIR CARE AT CHS?

According to the results of a recent survey, the great majority of CHS patients are very happy with the care they receive.
